- The proposed screenings of SNOW WHITE AND THE SEVEN DWARFS this week-end have been cancelled.

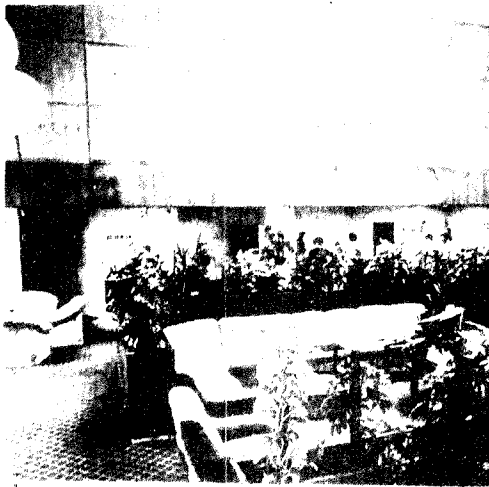
