Furthermore, each bedroom has a personality all its own.

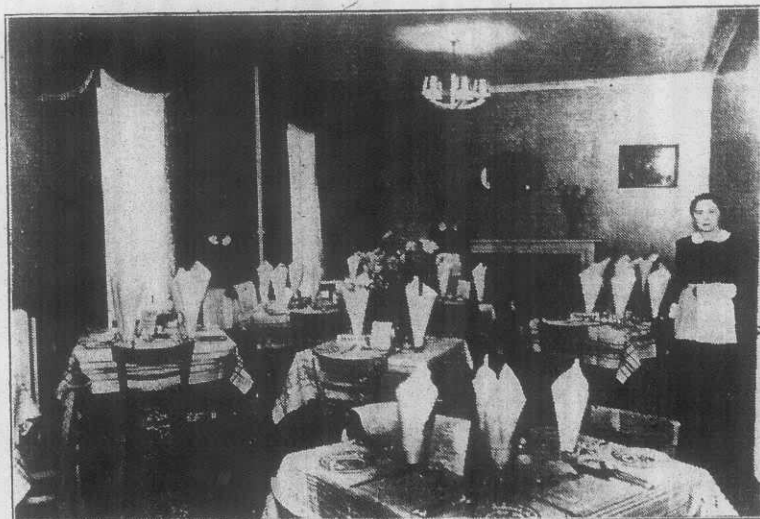
