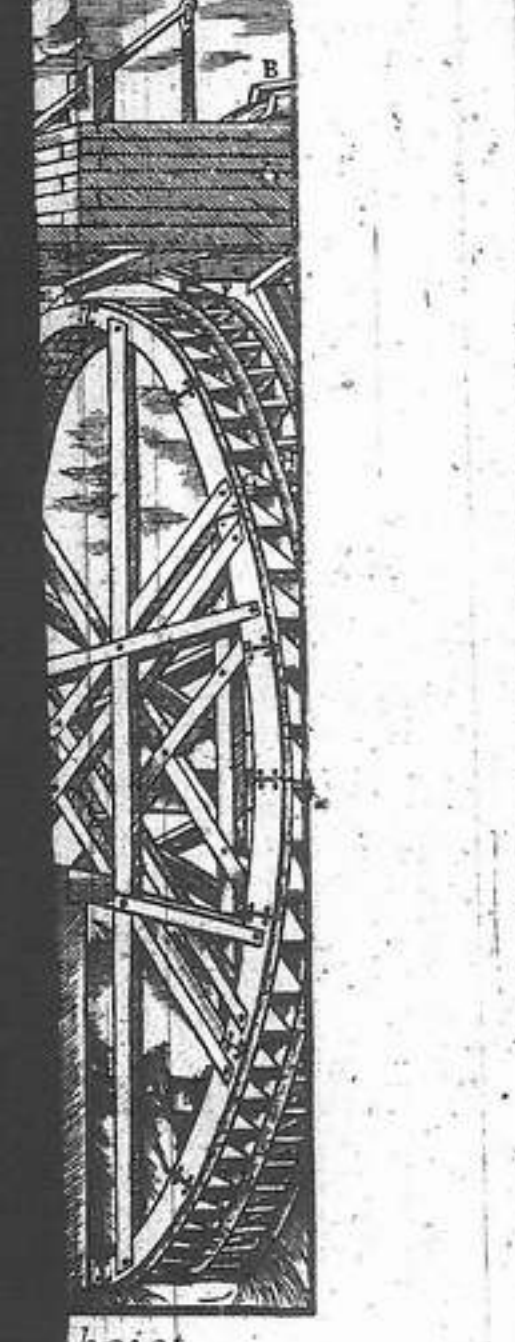

No. 222—The Men Who Were Ireland's Champion Hurlers Eighteen Years Ago

LAST week, by way of compliment to our young hurlers battling for our second minor crown, I gave short careers of the 1940 minor title...

JIM ROCHE. Connected with the G.A.A. almost since its inception, the Roche family (Croom) gave Jim to Limerick hurling when he was but six...

PADDY SCANLAN. Now meeting the men of 1940: Paddy Scanlan (Galway Gaelic) was the Limerick goalie during...

JOHN MACKAY. With his six feet bobbing in waves about him, John Mackay was another of that brilliant Ahane band...

JIM MCCARTHY. Jim McCarthy (Fenagh U.C.D.), had figured more than a dozen years old. He was of great Gaelic stock...

MICK MACKAY. Another son of the famous "Tyler" and Limerick's 1940 captain, Mick Mackay (Ahane), like his brother John...

MICK HICKEY. Mick Hickey (Ahane), nephew of Mick Danahy, who played great games with the old Castleconnell...

DICK STOKES. 1940's most talked of hurler must surely have been Dick Stokes (Pallas and U.C.D.), a good lad of farming stock...

MICK KENNEDY. Mick Kennedy (Young Ireland), came from a hurling family and area—the Ragg, near Thurles...

PADDY CLOHESY. Paddy Clohesy (Fedoramore), one of the grandest hurlers in the minor, made an early mark in 1927...

PETER CREGAN. Minister born, Auburn trained, well set Peter Cregan (Croom)—former and leading member of a most hurling family...

TIMMY RYAN. Captain of the team that won the Jubilee All-Ireland and skipper also of the side that crossed the Atlantic on the American tour...

When grilling, line the pan with aluminium foil. It will retain fat and keep the pan clean. Also, its shiny surface intensifies the heat.

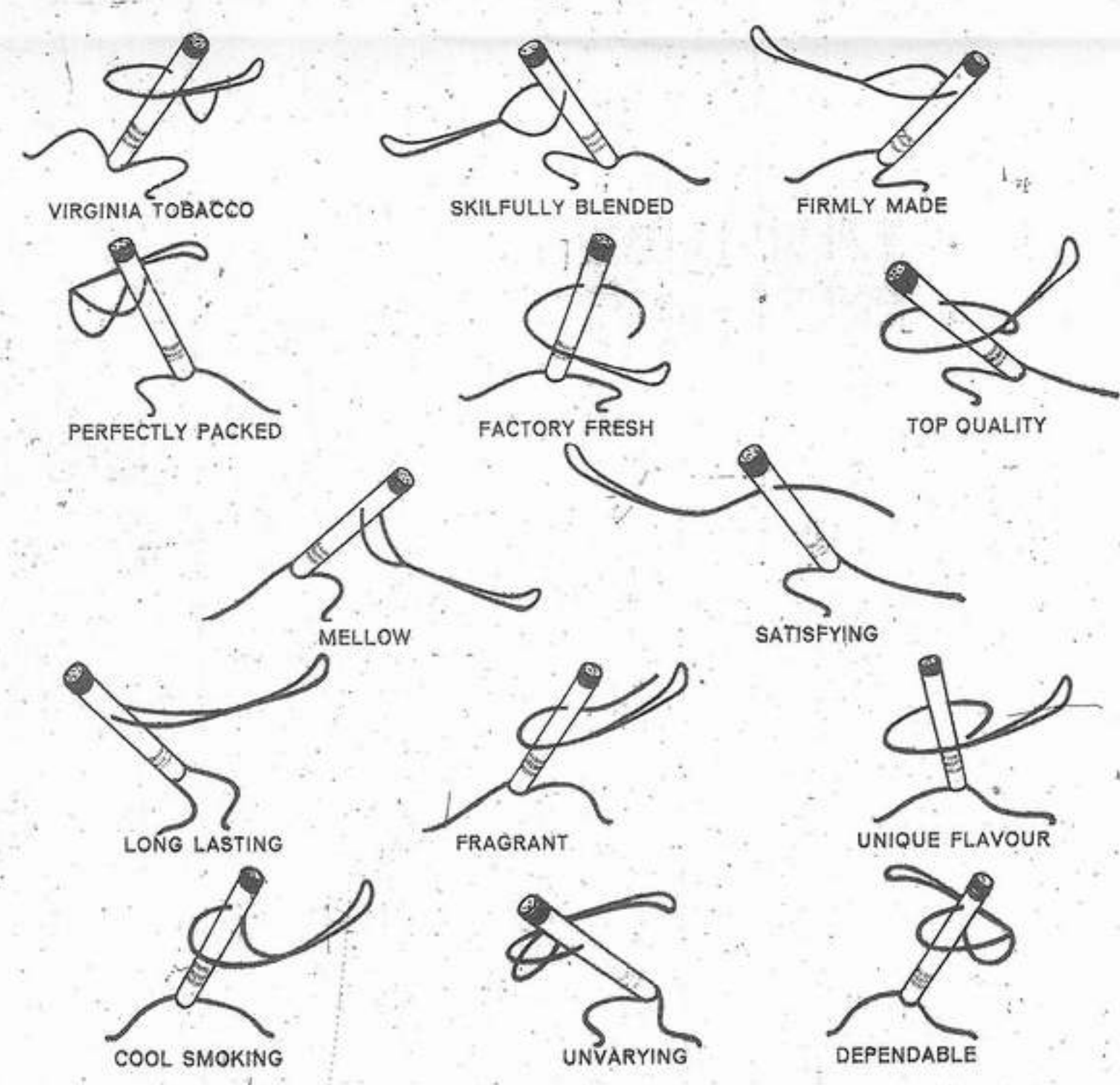
TONY HERBERT. Number sixteen ran on the Limerick side—he replaced Paddy Clohesy when injury forced the Fedamore man's retreat...

JACKY POWER. A star in both native codes, Jacky Power (Ahane) won the 1936 and 1940 All-Ireland hurling titles...

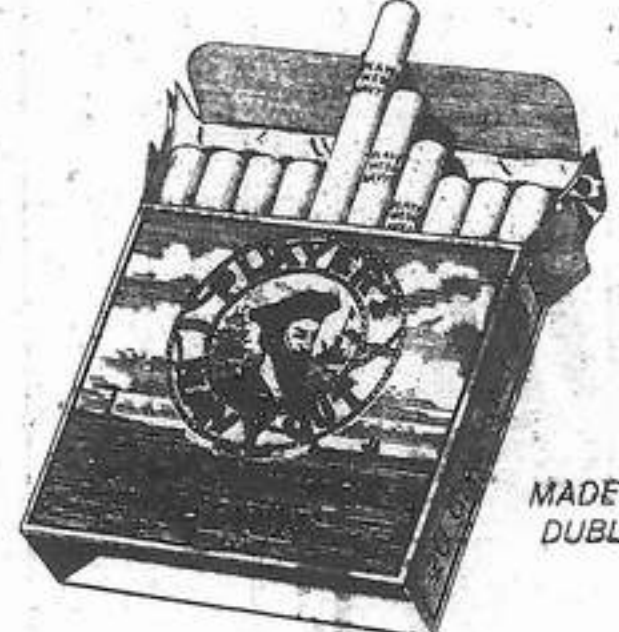
