It must travel more than 3,000,000,000 miles as long to reach us from the Hercules star. The cluster's distance is about 100 light years; that is, its light takes about that number of years to reach us. The mass of the whole cluster is probably in excess of 100,000 suns, for the cluster as a whole seems to be moving at far over a hundred miles a second. Compared with the great star clusters, our system appears insignificant, and only a yellow dwarfish, very old star, eccentrically situated in a large moving star

universe."
