

Farmer's Tragic Death

Found on Roadside Near Bruff

An inquest was held in Bruff, county Limerick, on Saturday on the body of an elderly farmer, John Keane (72), Holy Cross, near Bruff, who was found lying on the roadside half way between his house and the town.

The inquest was held by Coroner Dr Cleary, and Supt. Flood represented the Gardai.

Evidence was given of the finding of the body by the side of the road by some people going to Mass on St. Patrick's Day. It was also stated that he had left Bruff on Thursday night to walk to his house two miles away.

Medical evidence was given by Dr Wolfe and Dr O'Connor to the effect that death was due to shock and exposure.

A verdict in accordance with the medical evidence was returned.
