Death of Mr E J Phelps

The death has occurred of Mr E J Phelps, K C, one of the best known members of the Irish Bar. A native of Waterpark, Castleconnell, he was second son of the late John Lecky Phelps and was aged 76 years. He was educated at Eton and Oxford and was called to the English Bar in 1892, where he practiced until called to the Irish Bar in 1898.

In 1893 Mr Phelps was made a Bachelor of the King's Inns, and in 1924 took silk. He was an authority on Fishery and Railway Law. He was a Judge of the Court of the General Synod and was Chancellor of the Diocese of Cork, Kilmore, Ossory and Killaloe, and was a member of the Board of King's Hospital School, the Molyneux Asylum for the Blind, and the McGeough Home.
