

Gored by Bull.

Inquest on County Farmer

Mr M E Cussen, solicitor, Coroner for West Limerick, sitting with a jury at the home of the deceased, held an inquest into the circumstances connected with the death of James Quinlivan (66) farmer, Ardaman, Rathkeale, who died from injuries received as a result of being gored by a bull when himself and his brother were driving the animal from one field to another across the road near their home.

Dr W Mulcahy, M O, Rathkeale, having described the injuries, said death was due to shock and haemorrhage.

Recording a verdict of accidental death, the Coroner expressed sympathy with the bereaved relatives, and joining in the vote, the foreman of the jury (Mr P McIntyre) complimented the Army authorities on the promptness with which they arrived on the scene and destroyed the bull after the accident.
