## Lorry Driver's Shocking Death

James Coffey, Lacey street, Tipperary, died in the County Infirmary, Limerick, on Saturday night as the result of injuries sustained when a lorry which he was driving from Limerick to Tipperary overturned on the road at Ballysimon. The deceased was driving the lorry which belonged to his employers, the Condensed Milk Company of Ireland. There was no one on the scene when the accident occurred but the vehicle was completely overturned on the road, and deceased sustained shocking injuries. He died some minutes after being admitted to hospital.
