

Limerickman's Death

Inquest Adjourned

After evidence of identification and medical evidence had been given, Dr D A MacErlan, Dublin city coroner, opened and adjourned an inquest in the Richmond Hospital on Monday on Timothy Murphy, aged 20, carpenter, of Ballygran, who died in the hospital on Saturday. — He had been involved in a collision with a motor car whilst cycling near Charleville on March 18 last and was removed to Croom hospital. He was transferred to the Richmond hospital in July.

Dr C Dallen, house surgeon, said that death in his opinion was due to cardiac failure secondary to cerebral abscess.

Inspector Collins applied for an adjournment so that further enquiry could be made by the Gardaí at Limerick.
