

# Co. Limerick Priest's Death

At Templeglantine on Sunday afternoon, a large number from Templeglantine, Abbeyfeale, Newcastle West and Tour, attended the interment in the reserved plot beside the church, of the Rev John Houlihan, P.P. Inducted in his pastorate a little more than twelve months ago, his death came as a great shock to his people and the great many numbered amongst the friends who mourn his loss. Right Rev Monsignor Haonan, P.P., V.G., of Newcastle West, assisted by over 30 members of the clergy, recited the prayers at the graveside. Mr Eamon Kissane, T.D. represented Mr de Valera, and units of the Abbeyfeale, Templeglantine and Tournafalla L.D.F., V.A.D. and Red Cross, in full members and equipment, were present, and on the previous evening had supplied a guard of honour when the remains were met on their way from Dublin, at which there was also a very large attendance of the general public. He was an ardent patriot and a prominent member of the Gaelic League. His death is deeply regretted in West Limerick.
