

# Limerick Co. Lady's Death

Mrs Margaret Clery, who died at The Cottage, Ballyculhane, Kilmallock, was a member of a well known County Limerick family. Relict of the late Mr J J Clery, who was one of the well-known Clery farming family that has connections with the county for generations, she had reached the fine old age of 80 years. She was the mother of Mr P B Clery, auctioneer, Kilmallock, and of Mr T Clery, O R, member of the well-known engineering firm of Sheahan and Clery, Limerick. The late Dr P Clery, Kilmallock, and the late Mr Mark Clery, well known farmer, were brothers-in-law of the deceased. After Requiem Mass in Belgaden Church, the interment took place in the presence of a large congregation that was representative of all classes of the community, and was testimony of the high esteem and respect in which the deceased lady was held. The interment took place at Belgaden.
