## Fatal Accident On The Ennis Road

While walking on the Limerick Ennis Road, near Clondrinagh, Caberdavin, on Saturday evening, an aged man named Frederick Mason came into collision with a motor car and sustained fatal injuries.

Mason, who was aged about 78 years, was an inmate of the Protestant Aid Home, Reeve's Path, Limerick. He was a widower and a retired jeweller. He was walking in the direction of Ennis when the accident occurred. The motor car involved was driven by Mr Michael Ring, Sixmile-bridge.

The deceased was conveyed in the Corporation ambulance to the Co Infirmery, where life was pronounced extinct. He had two broken legs and other injuries.
