Outstanding Facts In The History Of An Old Limerick Family

ODDS AND ENDS

Great Doings In The Parish

THE recent death of Mrs. Howley, of Rich Hill, Lisnagry, recalls some outstanding facts in the history of an old Limerick family of much prominence. These details are contained in the following interesting special article written by one who wishes to subscribe himself "A Friend," and intended as an appreciation of the late Mrs. Howley and of the family into which she married nearly sixty years ago.

THE death has occurred at Rich Hill, Lisnagry, of Evelina Eliza Howley, widow of William Howley. Although Mrs. Howley had reached a fine old age, her many years of life were not without interest and activity. She was born in 1785, and was the daughter of a Limerick family of much prominence. She was married to William Howley in 1815, and they had several children. She was a devout Catholic and a member of the Limerick Guild of St. Mary's. She was a very kind and generous person, and was much loved by her family and friends.

Two daughters and two sons were born of the marriage between John Howley and Amy Burke. The younger daughter, Emily, married Alan Francis O'Neill, merchant of Limerick and Liverpool. The elder son, John (1789-1868) entered the legal profession and rose to the rank of First Sergeant. The younger son, John (1791-1867) succeeded to the Rich Hill property. John Howley himself prospered in business and became one of the leading citizens of the city. A fact that is commemorated in the name of one of Limerick's quays.
