DEATH OF NONAGENARIAN

Mrs. Ellen Murphy, aged ninety
years, died at Broadford last week
(writes our Knockaderry corres-
pondent). An expert needlewoman,
she plied her craft with possession
of all her faculties up to a few
days prior to her demise. She
worked in London during a great
part of Queen Victoria's reign.
Being associated with a Court
dressmaker she was very familiar
with all Court gossip of those times.
Her husband, Matthew Murphy,
who was over 80 when he died, pre-
deceased her some years ago. He
was a member of the London
Metropolitan Police and was on
special duty in Whitechapel on the
night Jack the Ripper claimed his
last victim, who, it was stated, was
a Limerick woman. Mrs. Murphy
was buried alongside her husband
at Kileedy Churchyard.
