DIES IN SAN FRANCISCO DIOCESE

The death of the Rev. Cornelius
Greaney, C.C., of St. Anne's Parish,
Oakland, San Francisco, occurred
on the 21st inst. at the Providence
Hospital, Oakland (writes our
Abbeyfeale correspondent). De-
ceased was son of the late Michael
and Mrs. Greaney, of New Street,
Abbeyfeale. Aged about 40 years,
he ministered in the San Francisco
Diocese for about 18 years. A
popular and very much respected
young clergyman, his death is
widely regretted by many relatives
