Limerick District Lunatic Asylum
TO COAL MERCHANTS.
THE Committee of Management of the above
Asylum will hold a meeting to be held
on WEDNESDAY, 13th DECEMBER, 1918, con-
sidering tenders for supplying the institution with
200 Tons Best Coal (beds) to be supplied
by "through and through," and be supplied
from some of the following collieries:—Lewin-
Meath, Glens, O'Connell, St. Helena, Camber-
land, Williamstown, Newcastle, Newcastle
Navigation, International, Ebbw Vale, or Great
Western Steam. The Coal must be fresh
wrought at the time of shipment, and be
delivered to the Asylum, direct from ship to
Asylum and "Colliery Certificate" and "Bill of
Lading" to be furnished before delivery. The
delivery to be continuous until complete, and
not less than 100 tons each day, between the
hours of 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., otherwise a penalty
of 50/- per day will be enforced. The coal must
be supplied within 14 days of acceptance of the
tender, and be weighed on the Harbour
Commissioners' scales before delivery. The
contractors will be required to deliver the coal
to the Asylum, and to be ready to deliver to

"Steam Coal," and sent in not later than
