THE MUNGRET STREET "milk market" will undergo a £500,000 refurbishment if Cllr. Paddy Madden gets his way. The Fianna Fail councillor was appalled at the traffic chaos in the area over the Christmas.

Cllr. Madden, who is a member of the Market Trustees, which is in liquidation, believes that the situation will be cleared up in the current year, thus ending the longest ever liquidation in Ireland.

Confident

Plans have been drawn up for the re-development of the market by Murray and O'Laoire, architects, and Cllr. Madden is now confident that these can be carried out in 1988 at a cost of about £500,000.

"I am really looking forward to it, and I can tell you that I will be doing everything in my power to make sure that everything is completed by next Christmas," he said approvingly.

"The traffic chaos in the

area was unbelievable and just cannot be permitted to be repeated under any circumstances," he added.

He said that even when the refurbished Milk Market was finally opened it might be necessary to close off some streets in the area.

Traders

In the meantime, Cllr. Madden wants all of the traders, currently trading in the Mungret Street area on Saturday, to be moved to the new Potato Market.

"I have spoken to Denis Leonard about the idea, and he is all for it," he argued. "The more traders that use the Potato Market the better - sure they have all the space in the world there."
