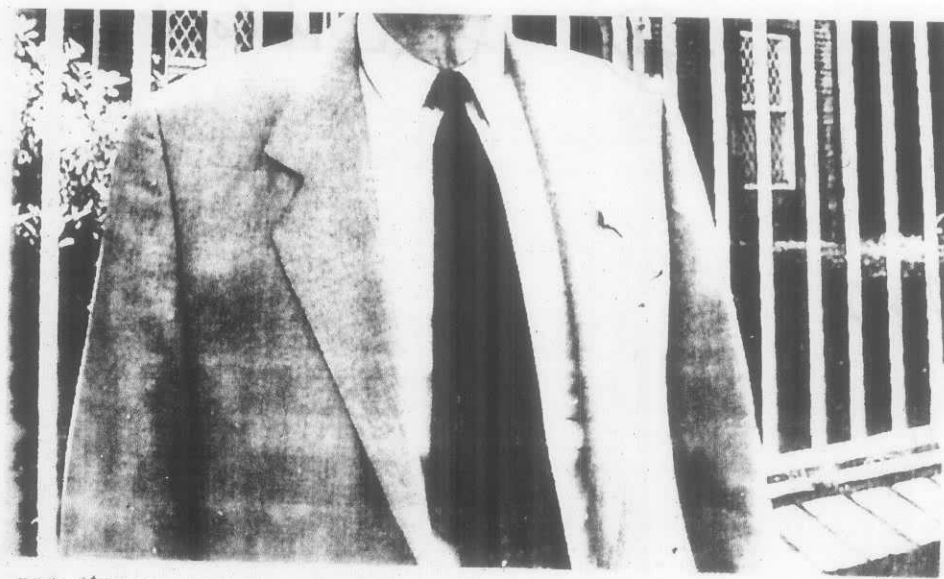

Paddy Malone: welcomes resignation

# Malone happy as McCourt resigns

AN old classmate of Frank McCourt has welcomed his resignation from the Hunt Museum's board of directors.

Paddy Malone, Mr McCourt's biggest critic, said he was delighted that the Pulitzer prize-winning author had resigned from his post at the museum. He alleged Mr McCourt didn't deserve the honorary position as he had got it with untruths in Angela's Ashes.

Mr Malone, who once ripped up a copy of the book in front of McCourt at a signing in Limerick, claims the author "made a mockery of the dead" with his depiction of poverty in the city.

"I am delighted Frank McCourt has resigned from the Hunt Museum after mounting pressure on him to do so.

"I am not a vindictive person, but he should have resigned. I know the difference between fact and fiction and his memoirs accounting life in Limerick are fiction. He has made a mockery of the poor and of the dead and they are two things that you just don't do," he said.

Mr Malone is taking legal action against Frank McCourt for the use of a photograph on the cover of Angela's Ashes. He claims the original belonged to his mother.

According to a spokesman for the Hunt Museum, Mr McCourt had been on the board of directors for the past two years. He had resigned from his honorary position as he spent very little time in Ireland and was not able to play a more active role.
