McCourt memorial is no 'melancholic affair'

IT'S one month since the death of Frank McCourt - and celebrations of his life and work are continuing across America.

Hundreds of fans of the late author attended his month's mind Mass in New York this Wednesday.

Family members, friends, and past high school students attended the ceremony in the Holy Name of Jesus Church on West 96th Street, where Fr Brian Jordan promised "we are going to cry, laugh and dance".

The Angela's Ashes author died on July 19 and would have celebrated his 79th birthday this Wednesday.

The former United States president Bill Clinton, who Mr McCourt became acquainted with, also shared the same birthday.

At an earlier memorial of the author in Rosie O'Grady's bar in New York, Mr Clinton drew howls from the crowd after recalling how Frank had not liked his own memoir, My Life.

As Frank once proclaimed he didn't know what a birthday party was when he was growing up in Limerick, one of his former students is also throwing a party in his honour this week.

Meanwhile, Fr Jordan said the
