Death of William (Bill) Broggy

MR. WILLIAM (Bill) Broggy of Herberton Road, Dublin, who has died, was a veteran of the Spanish Civil War who had fought on Franco's side in 1936-'37.

A native of Meelick, near Limerick, he had been a civil servant attached to the Forestry Department in Dublin.

A great G.A.A. enthusiast, he was one of the founders of the Rialto Gaels Dublin Club and helped train the Dublin minor hurling team of 1958.

He was a tremendous follower of the fortunes of the Limerick senior hurling team, so much so that he never missed a League title in which they were engaged during the winter months.

Nothing gave him more joy than Limerick's memorable All-Ireland title win in 1973. The Limerick followers who poured into Dublin during All-Ireland week-end that season will recall Bill putting a little figure decked out in the Green and White in a prominent place in O'Dwyer's of Leeson Street.

Celebrated

He had written across the base of it: "Limerick All-Ireland Champions, 1973."

Some diehard Kilkenny followers ribbed him: "But they are not champions yet?"

"What is written is written," he replied, and later he celebrated with his friends with the £40 he bet on Limerick with a chap from the States who had the temerity to lay 5/4 against the Shannonsiders.

These and other moments were recalled by the many G.A.A. followers and also by G.A.A. correspondents and people from all walks of life who attended his funeral in Dublin.

Not alone was he an outstanding hurling enthusiast, but also a great follower of the fortunes of the Dubs. But then he was a true all-round sportsman who had a few dogs of his own and was frequently to be seen at Shelbourne Park.

He is survived by his wife, Marie, and by seven sons, John, William, Aidan, Cecil, Seamus, Brian and Laurence, and by one daughter, Kathleen.
