FATHER JOHN RYAN, S.J., M.A., D.Litt.

Father Ryan was born in Castleconnell, Co. Limerick, and had his early education there prior to going to Crescent College, Limerick, for his secondary course. On the completion of his secondary studies he entered the Society of Jesus. He graduated at University College, Dublin, and pursued further courses at Louvain, Belgium; Valkenburg, Holland; the University of Bonn and Münster in Westphalia, Germany, and holds M.A. and D.Litt degrees. He was ordained in Dublin in 1926.

He was appointed Lecturer in Early Irish History at University College, Dublin, in 1931 and has held the Professorship since 1942. He is a Past President of the Royal Society of Antiquaries of Ireland; Member of the board of Celtic Studies; and member of Dublin Institute for Advanced Studies.

He also has held appointment as Occasional Lecturer in the Gregorian University, Rome, 1951 to 1961.

He has written a monumental work, Irish Monasticism, and two smaller books on Irish History which have great popularity in schools, as well as various articles in learned Irish and continental periodicals.
