



Dr. William Carte

Dr. William Carte (c.1829–1899) was a Limerick man who spent his childhood in Tasmania and came to Dublin in his teens to study medicine and surgery. After studying at the **Royal College of Surgeons**, he got a job as an assistant surgeon in the British army.

Dr. Carte served in Turkey and Crimea before coming to the Royal Hospital as a physician and surgeon c.1858. Dr. Carte had an official residence at the Royal Hospital, where he died in April 1899 at the age of 70. He is buried in the **Officers' Graveyard**.
