Christmas show shines the light of the Silver Moon on the Belltable

LIMERICK band Fox Jaw are releasing *Heel to Toe*, a stand-alone winter-infused single, accompanied by a unique hometown show they are calling *Ivory, Wine and Song*.

Crooning takes over from amplification, electric guitars are replaced by acoustics and frontman Ronan Mitchell takes a seat behind the piano to play a very different kind of Fox Jaw set, along with a rare collection of Christmas classics.

Over the last decade, Fox Jaw have grown from strength to strength, evolved, overcome and journeyed across Europe and North America with their signature sound. A few years older, wiser and with lessons learned and they're still just getting started.

Described as 'a modern band with an old soul', they have a swaggering trend-shaking growl, but always kept it sweet and melodic with an honest collection of dark pop songs.
