The Nu Killa Kru have been promoting the drum & bass sound in Limerick for almost 2 years now at Nu Killa Beatz, their weekly Thursday night downstairs

This team of local Dj's have built up a sizeable, loyal following within that time and have given the Limerick dance scene a much needed injection of vibrancy and diversity. Founder members Code, Bee & Roller T had been involved in the local scene since the days of \$kint, the legendary Limerick breakbeat club. However, after it's demise, the trio were without a medium with which they could express their unique sound. It was sometime later (after they had begun their own radio show on Limerick's Touch 107Fm) that they decided to start promoting their own nights.

Their first was in December 1999, a collaboration with Dublin's purveyors of the drum and bass sound, Bassbin. The night saw Roller T, Don Rosco of Bassbin and Dj Fierce enthu siastic and energetic crowd in the Globe. After witnessing such

a good response and with the encouragement of the Bassbin boys in their ears, the Nu Killa Kru decided that there was a place for a dedicated drum & bass night in Limerick - something which never previously existed. Nu Killa Beatz was born.

Coming up to their second birthday the lads are still going strong. The Kru's new members: Deep Cut, Hiteck, Skerry, Evil Grin, Leon, Exhibit A and Weenz (a recently recruited MC) have become an integral part of the weekly night adding different styles of drum and bass/jungle and also adding the hip-hop sound to the equation. Keep an eye out for the monthly parties on the ground floor of the Globe, which really go off! The next one is Thursday the 13th of December - warm-up @ the Dog House.
