His first DVD 'Live In Concert' won the DVD of the Year award in 2007 and has been shown coast to coast on US television on more than one occasion.

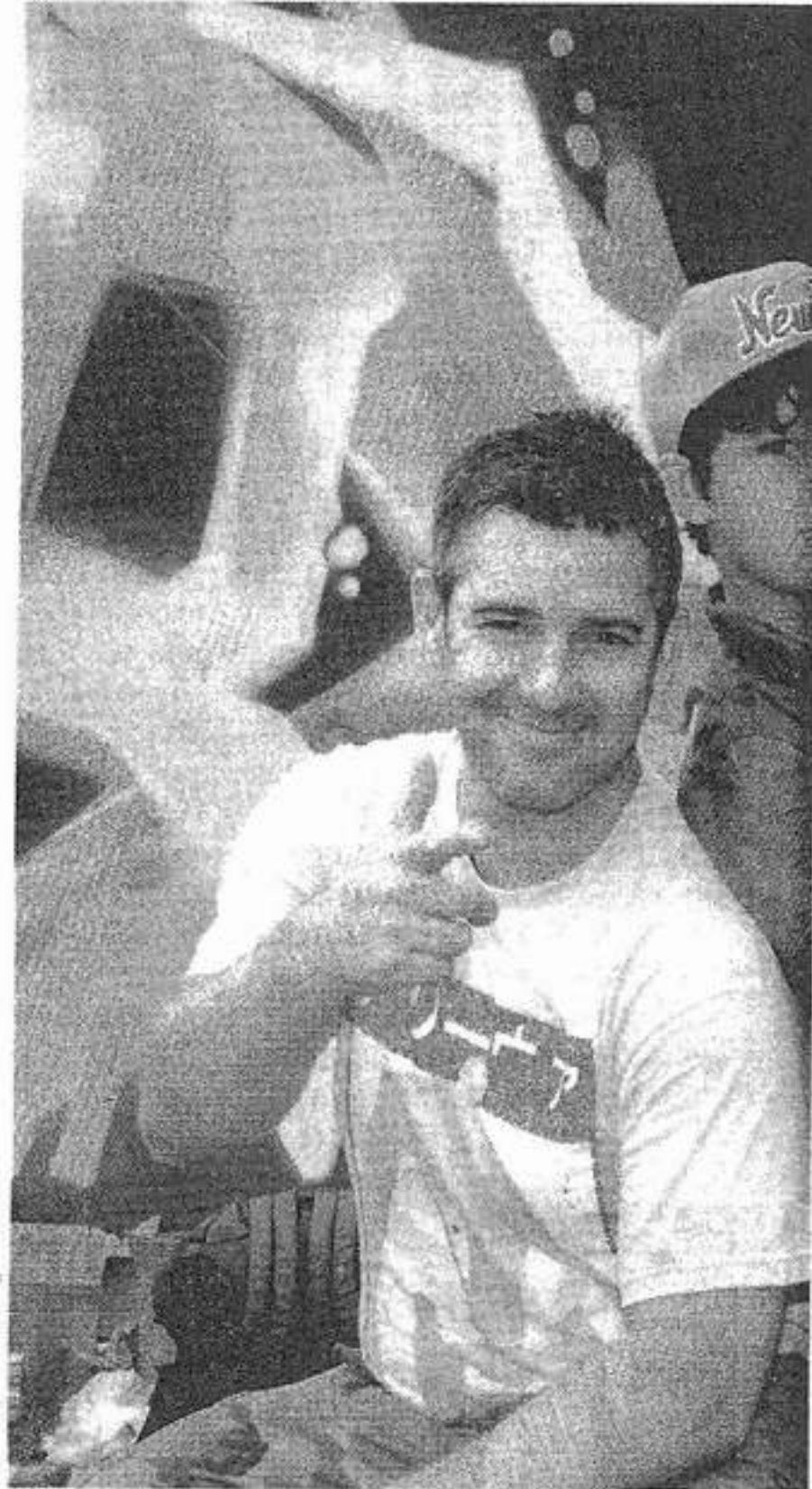
