GIG OF THE WEEK

A NEW LOOK FOX JAW GET READY FOR LIMERICK LAUNCH OF NEW SINGLE KEROSENE

A NEW look Fox Jaw mark the recent release of single Kerosene with a much anticipated gig in an equally new look Cobblestone Joe's this Friday night.

The Limerick band, boasting a new line-up and shortened moniker ahead of the release of their second album Ghost's Parade, play the rescheduled gig from earlier this month in the Little Ellen Street venue, which has undergone major refurbishment work in recent weeks.

The new single is an early and intriguing taster from the upcoming album, a menacing,

growing three minute odd slab of the brooding rock and roll - with a memorable guitar solo - that we have come to expect from them.

The band recorded with producer Dave 'Skipper' Christophers and the album was mastered by WAV Mastering maestro Richard Dowling. The release will be a follow-up to excellent 2011 debut The Devil In Music.

Joyce's A Portrait comes to 69 O'Connell Street

AN interesting production of the James Joyce classic text *A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man* comes to 69 O'Connell Street this week.

The New Theatre production, directed by Jimmy Fay and adapted for the stage by Tony Chesterman, moves to the city theatre after a sell-out run in Dublin.

The piece, which features Joyce's fictional alter ego Stephen Dedalus, contains some of the most dramatic scenes in modern literature.

It runs in the theatre this Wednesday night at 8pm. The theatre - formerly the Belltable - has secured funding to continue the Lime Tree administered programme of performing and visual arts.
