German tour and EP for **Moscow Metro**



LIMERICK band Moscow Metro have released a video for 'Spirit of a City' from the forthcoming EP of the same name. "Spirit Of A City" explores several dark themes - feeling trapped by your

situation, death and loss, social tensions and escaping the aftermath of a failed relationship," says the band. Meeting through mutual friends, the quartet's early rehearsals took place in a storage warehouse, a ten foot by ten metal box that shook with sound vibrations, leading to the inspiration for their name. Today Moscow Metro's music is epic in sound and universal in language. In the coming months Moscow Metro will tour Ireland and Germany, playing Whelan's Dublin on March 13 and Nenagh Arts Centre on March 29 before moving on to play Karrera Klub, Berlin, May 24 and joining The National and Warpaint at The Maifeld Derby Festival in Mannheim on May 30.

German record deal for **Senakah**

LIMERICK group Senakah had a busy 2013 with the release of their second album, Human Relations, produced by Cranberries' guitarist Noel Hogan. The album was preceded by its first single, also called 'Human Relations', which saw huge success on both the national airwaves and in YouTube. A second single 'Ugly' proved to be another hit on the web, racking up over 200,000 views. Tracks from Human Relations have appeared on

national radio and television and the hard working band has been rewarded with full endorsement from audio equipment giants Peavey and the news that they've just been picked up by Kanoon Records in Germany, with a planned large scale German release coming this Summer along with a European tour. In the meantime Senakah release the single 'Sinking' on March 7; the band plays Cobblestone Joe's on Sunday March 16.

A TALENTED lyricist, composer, producer and DJ, Mike Skinner (aka The Streets) released his debut album 'Original Pirate Material' in 2002, mixing UK garage with hip hop and the authentic flow of a beat poet reflecting the lifestyle of club culture in Birmingham. Subsequent singles from that album included the Top 40 hits 'Don't Mug Yourself', 'Weak Become Heroes' and 'Let's Push Things Forward'.

The follow up album 'A Grand Don't Come for Free' was a bigger hit led by 2004's single 'Fit but you Know It'. After four albums charting his rise to fame and the downside of fame, the final The Streets' album 'Computers and Blues' was released in 2011.

After shelving The Streets, Mike Skinner launched a new project, called The D.O.T., along with Rob Harvey of The Music.
