the length, including nave and choir, is 88 feet. Columns of polished Aberdeen granite separate the nave from the aisles. There is a rose window over the main doorway and a tower, which rises to 80 feet at the side of the building. The builders were Messrs. Ryan & Sons, Limerick, the clerk of works was Mr. James Henderson; the architects were Messrs. Ashlin & Coleman of Dublin and the cost was £6,000.
