THE Minister for Health, Mr. O'Malley, was asked to include geriatric nurses in his new Health Service at an historic dinner of the Divisional Union of Soroptimists of the Six Counties and the Republic at Cruise's Hotel, Limerick, last Saturday night.

The 1,135-lb satellite, dubbed Ogo, carries more scientific instruments than any other satellite launched by the United States.
