THE year 1830 was a memorable one for Limerick.

In that year Messrs. P. McCarthy & Sons opened their huge furniture premises at 38 and 39 George Street (now O'Connell St.), in Limerick.

It is of interest to note that their first premises in Limerick can still be seen, as it occupies the portion overhead what is now known as Woolworths.


Going back over our files, in this instance, our associate paper, the "Limerick Chronicle," we found an advertisement on May 21st, 1887, which told us that "McCarthy's are Cabinet-makers and Upholsterers, Carpet Warehouses, Funeral Undertakers, Auctioneers and Valuers."

The main portion of their advertisement was devoted to the fact that "they have 1,000 brass and iron bedsteads to choose from" and that "they are remarkable for their strength, cleanliness and comfort."

Further down the advertisement, they state that "special prices will be quoted for quantities, and that the designs can be had on application."

An advertisement on November 19th of the same year, informed us that "they are the only house in Limerick exclusively devoted to the house-furnishing trades."

This announcement went on to say that the firm has "the largest stock in the South of Ireland, of furniture, carpets and floor-cloths, suitable for either the cottage or a mansion, and inspection of their goods is invited, when it will be found that they are of a remarkable quality and principally manufactured on the premises, and

all marked at the lowest cash prices."

Bridging the years to 1908, we read that "McCarthy's have a splendid selection of pianos, and that they only sell instruments which they know to be of exceptional merit and will stand the test of time."

The years roll on . . . the first world war passes

by and the clouds of the second are gathering and we find McCarthy's continuing a great modernised furniture showrooms in October, 1937, at 19 William Street.

An advertisement around that time went on to deal with "huge selections, keenest prices and special opening offers," and invited us to add to their joy.

potential customers to come and see the largest selection of furniture in Munster."

December, 1960, now becomes another milestone in the great local history of this firm, as they celebrate their 130th year in business by opening their new, enlarged, and completely renovated premises on the spot where they moved to, just 23 years ago.

The policy down through the years has been one of "value for money" — a policy introduced by the founder, Peter McCarthy, and which is still the yardstick by which his grandson Joseph, and family, continues the business on the threshold of the bustling '60's of the great 20th century.

A visit to this wonderful new showrooms, occupying five floors, will give the potential customer an idea of the quality and modernistic design of all household furniture, which can be purchased here at prices to suit all pockets.

The new frontage, towering 85 feet above the city's streets, was one of the most ambitious reconstruction achievements to be attempted in William St. for many, many years, and is a glowing testimony to the progressive vision and outlook of the McCarthy family, and their faith in the prosperity of Limerick City, which they have served so faithfully for so long.

We take this opportunity to wish the present members of the family continued success on this happy occasion, and the reader will notice from the many advertisements on these two pages that their many associates in business have also joined with us to add to their joy.
