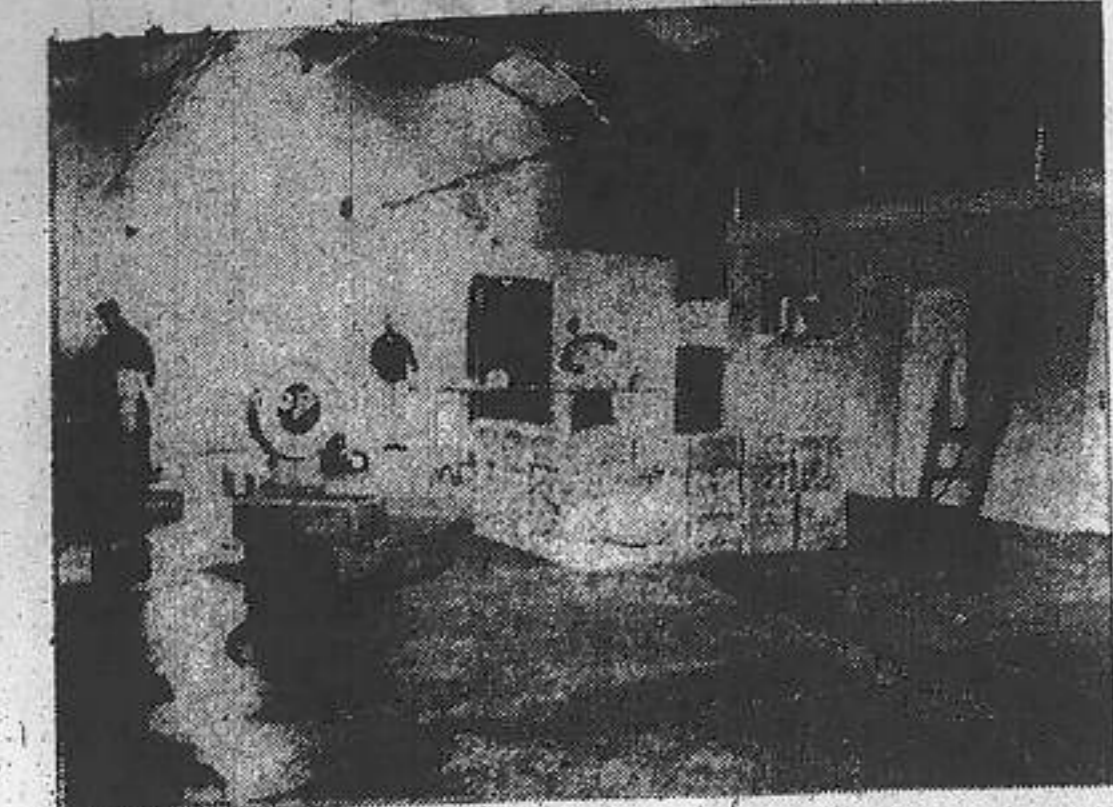

Plaid Stamps come to Limerick on Monday next and five centres have been allocated so far in the city.

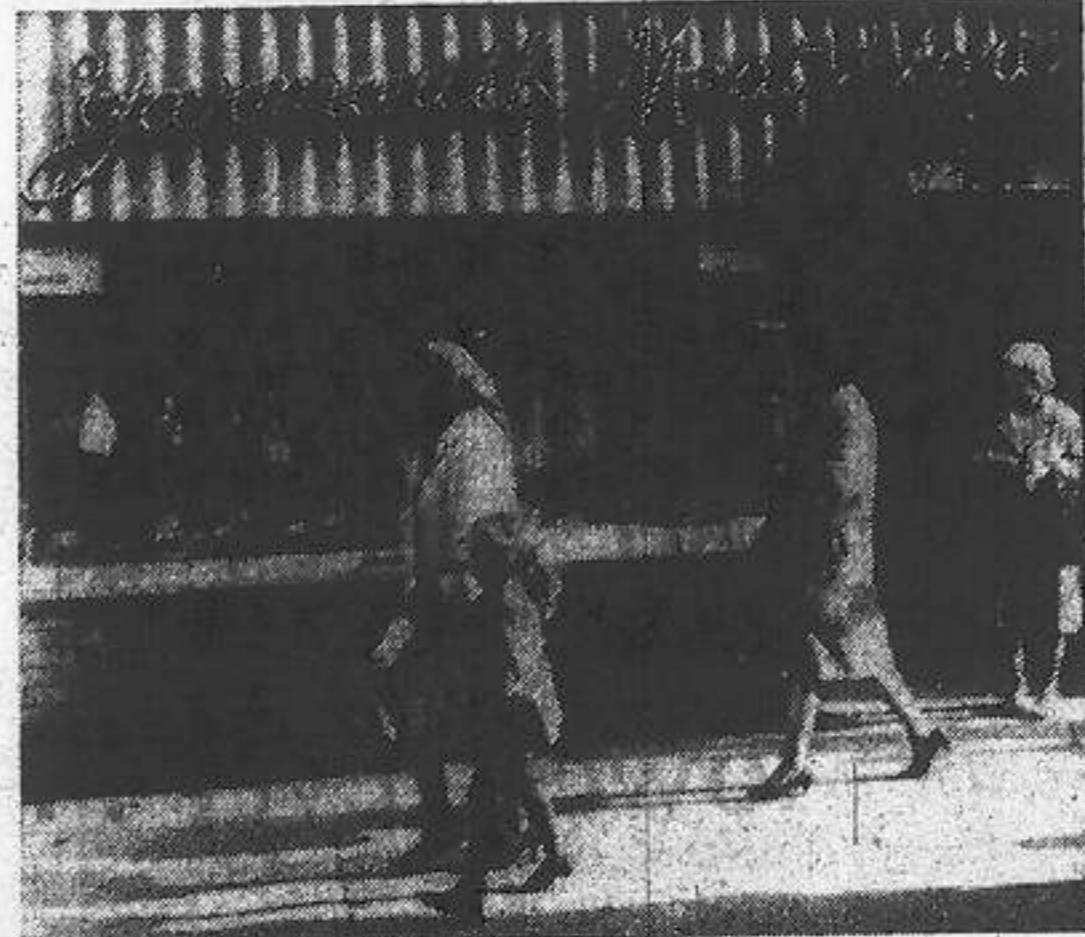

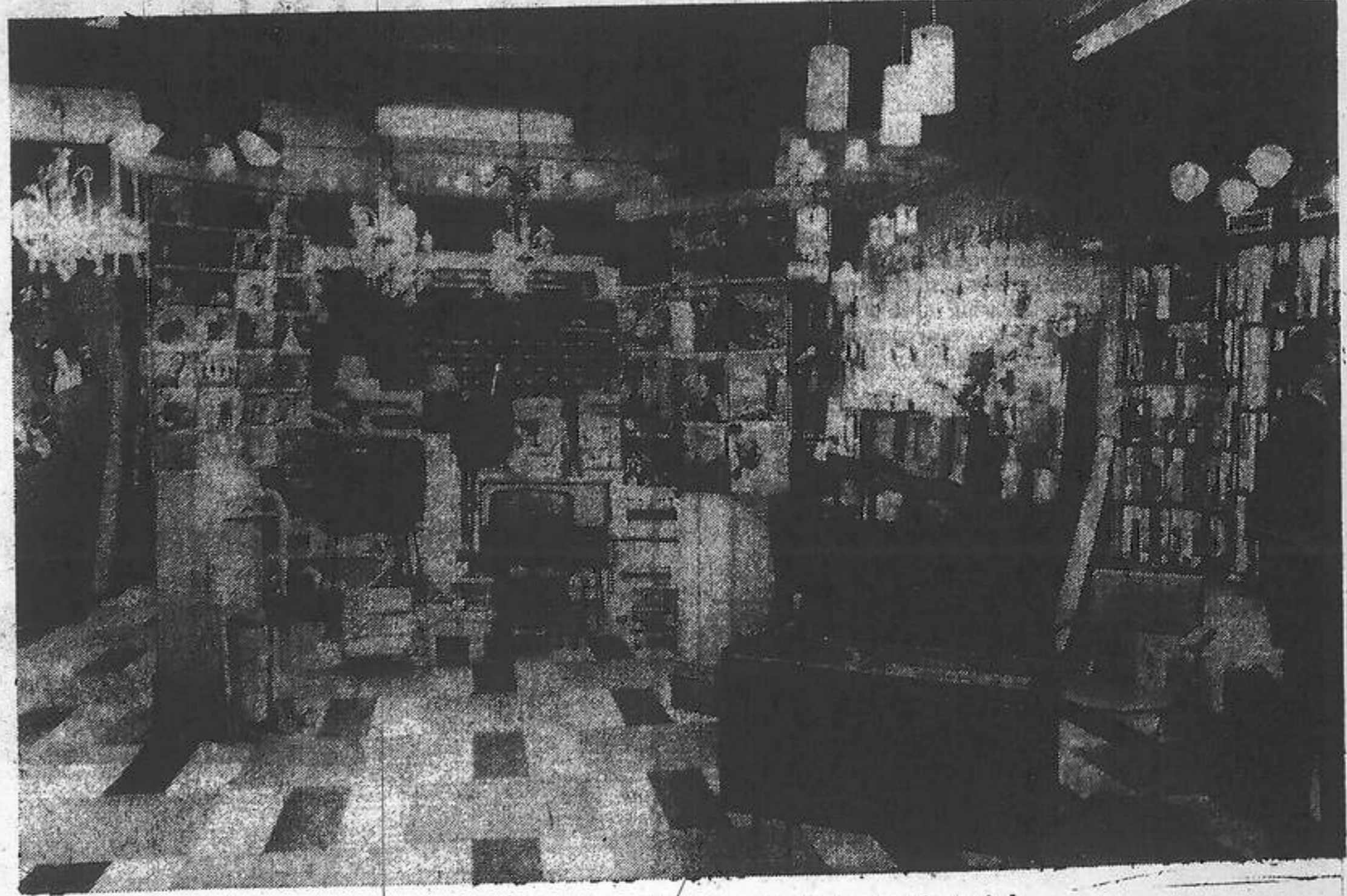
