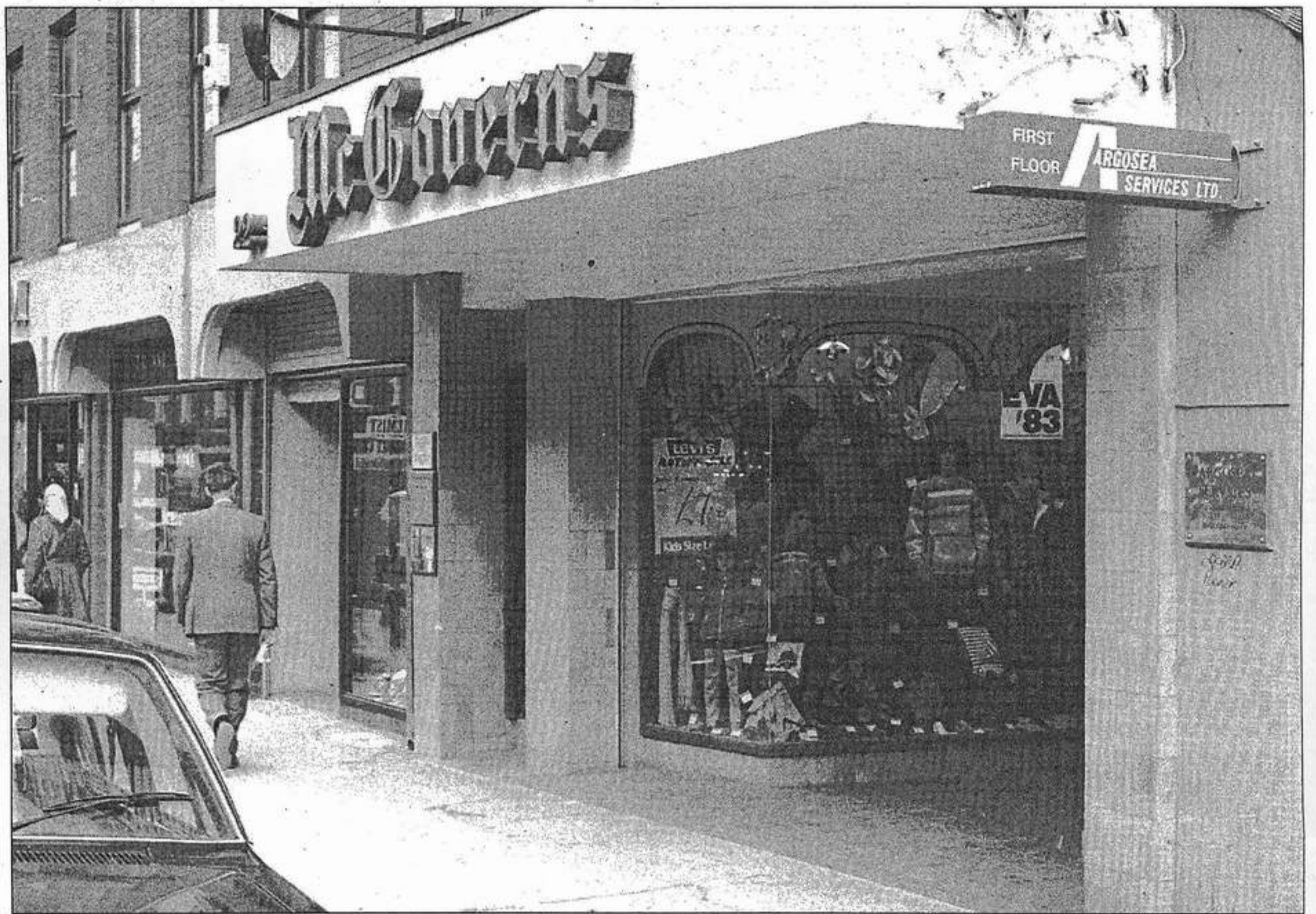

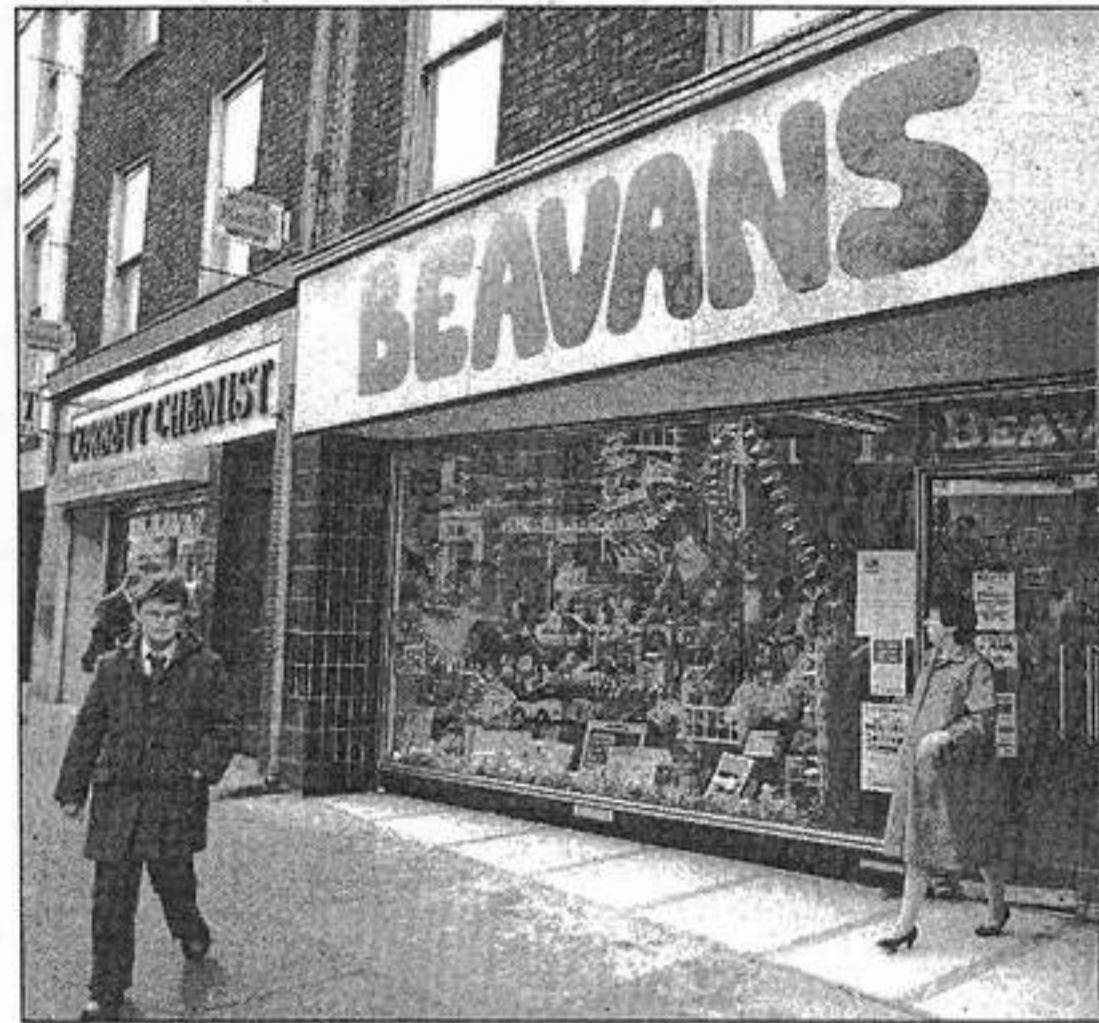
A passer by looks in the window of O'Connell's shoe repair shop, William Street, 29 years ago



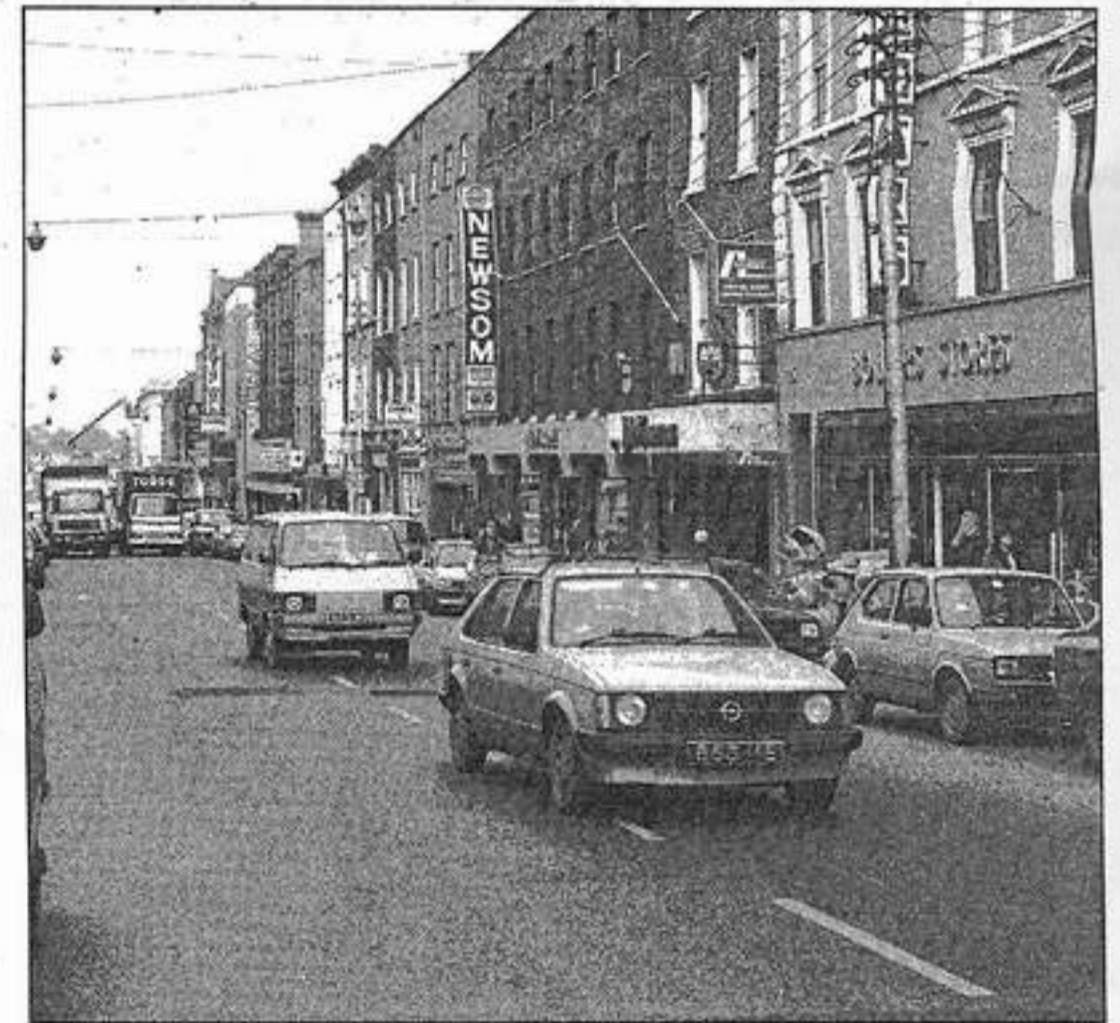
McGovern's shop for gentlemen and their sons was a William Street institution for many years. Countless Limerickmen were kitted out here!



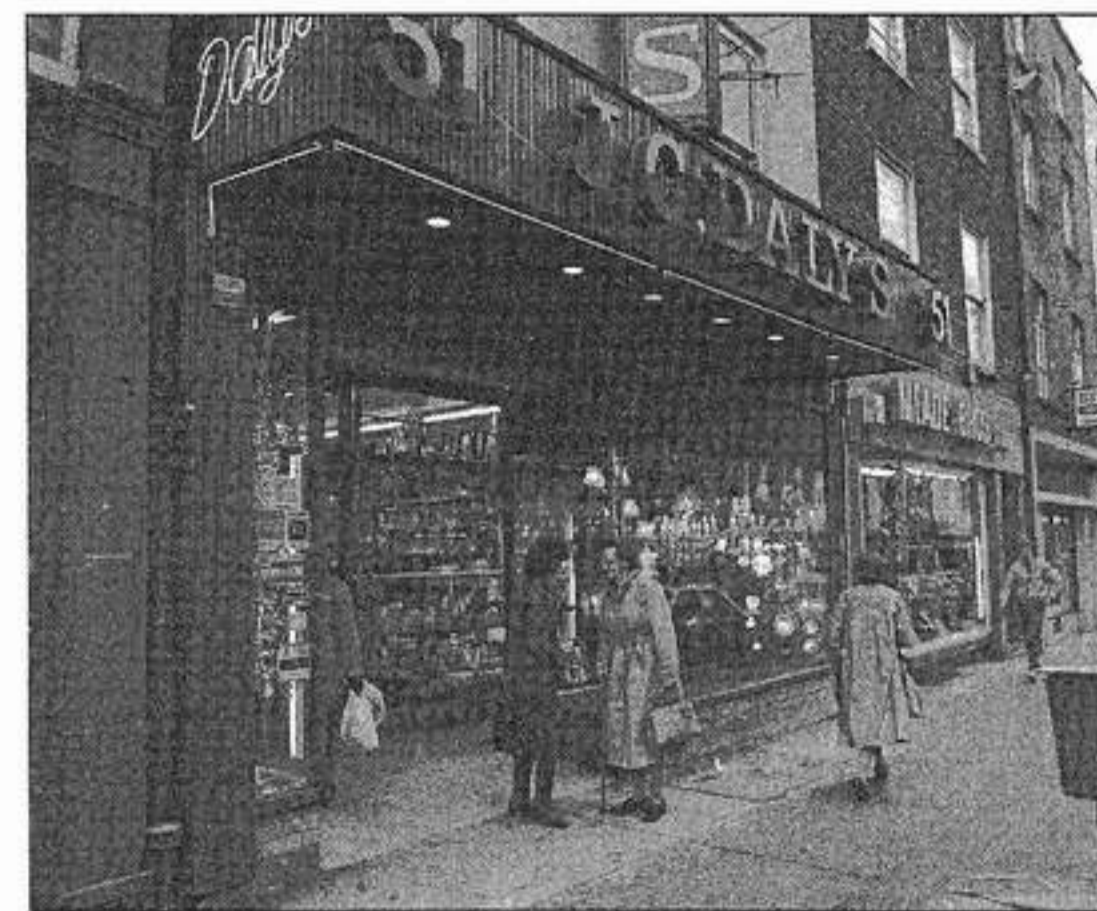
Walk on by: two elderly gents pass Tom Keane's curtain shop



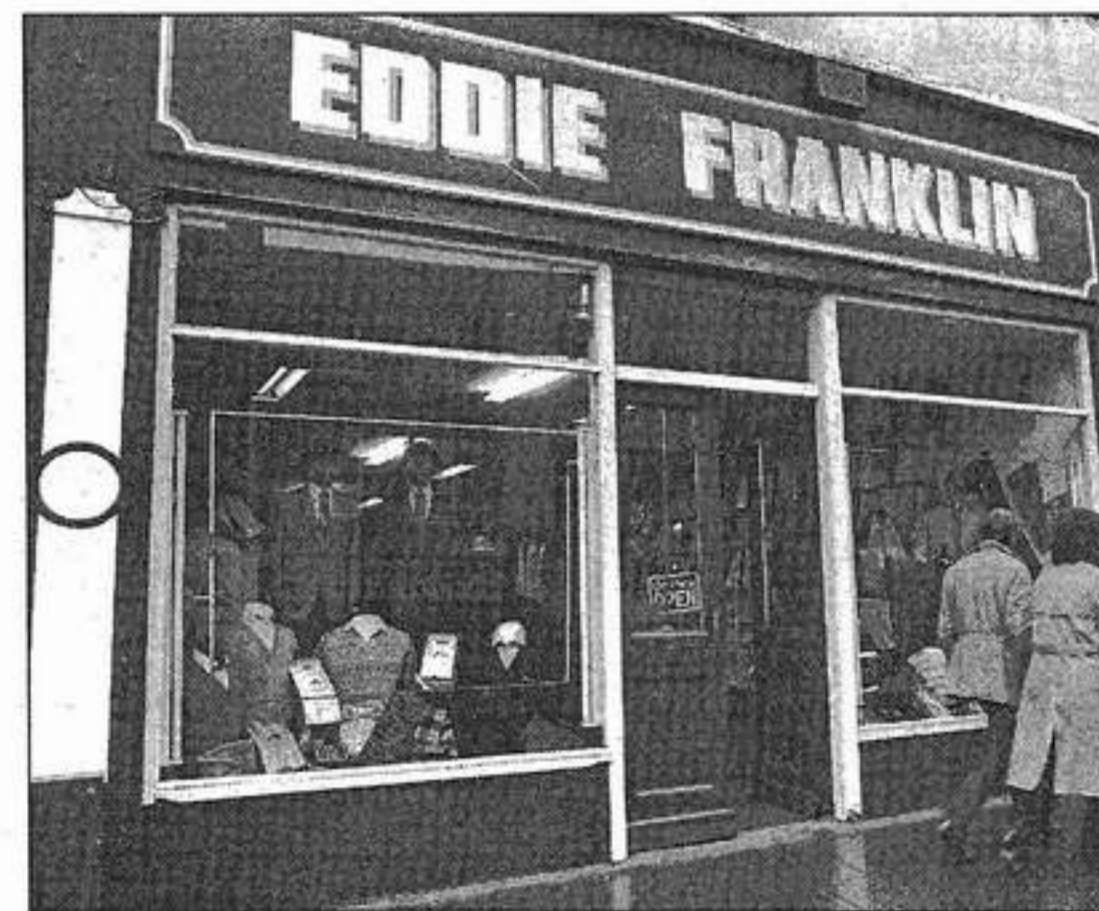
A lady is pictured leaving Beavan's shop, her business done



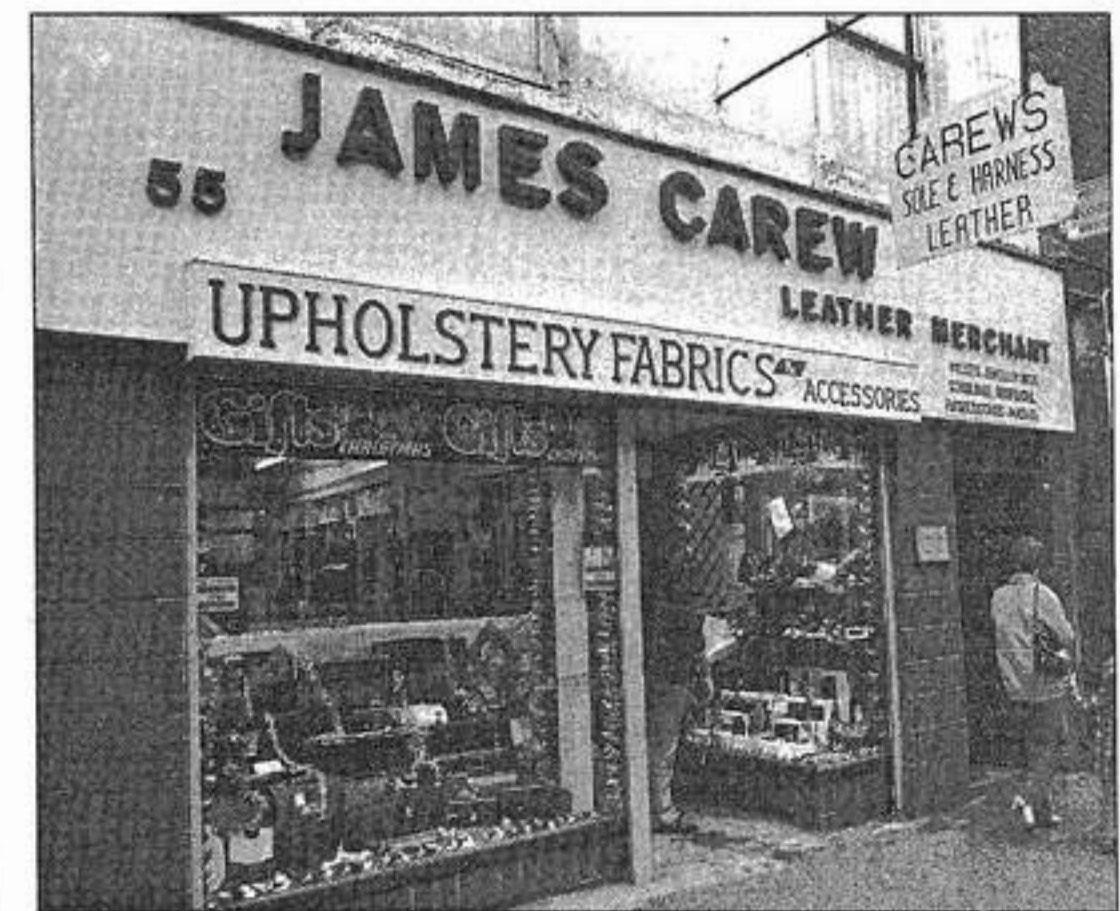
The view down William Street down towards O'Connell Street
