TROUBLE AGAIN FOR LIMERICK

DISSENSION has flared once again within the ranks of Limerick soccer club. This has angered others who signed on being told that no increases would be given to any player on last year's rate.

Goalie Kevin Fitzpatrick, one of Limerick's most loyal and outstanding clubmen for the of Limerick's most loyal and outstanding clubmen for the past ten years, took grave umbrage at this. He had been first to re-sign and did so without question but on the clear understanding that no player would receive anything more than had been paid last season but that the same rates as paid last season would be given.

Fitzpatrick signed on that understanding and was happy to again have his contract drawn up and completed. He did so in the firm belief that no member of the team would be getting extra wages.

SAW "RED"

When last week he became aware that a director had told the two players that he would pay them the extra money they were seeking out of his own pocket to get them to play, he saw "red," and left a training session in protest. He did not train any further that week
