city.

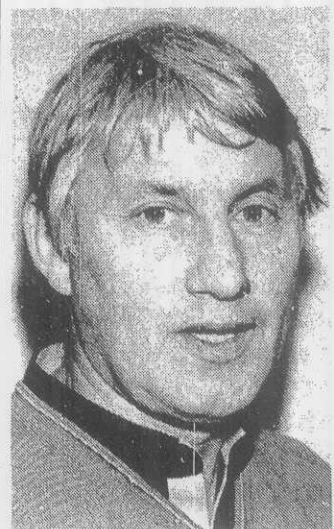
"It would be nice to relive
