
## Book Launch - Limerick Junior Soccer Chronicles

While Gerry McLoughlin is renowned for his prowess on the Rugby field he did not feel isolated on the night as all codes were represented at the launch.




folk in completing his project. He thanked the Limerick District League for their sponsorship in getting the book to print and Guinness and Glenisk Yogurts for their help with the launch.


