**MAGNIFICENT MARATHON RUN
 BY NIALL CUSACK**

Fastest ever by 19 year-old

NIALL CUSACK, formerly of St. Munchin's College and Limerick A.C., ran what is generally regarded as the fastest Marathon ever by a 19 year-old in Atlanta, Georgia, recently.

Cusack covered the 26 miles, 385 yards in 2 hours, 16 minutes, 18.2 seconds to set a new meet record for the Peachbowl Marathon, which this year attracted 150 entries, many of

them America's finest long distance exponents. Cusack, who will be 20 tomorrow (Thursday), took a wrong turn on the hilly course that cost him at least 20 seconds.

It was Cusack's first time running the marathon, so it was no wonder that he commented afterwards . . . "I have found my true event." Barry Browne (Florida Track Club) was 2nd in 2 hours, 24 minutes, 7 seconds, and 3rd was another Irish challenger, Eddie Leddy, in 2 minutes, 26.8 seconds. Cusack, like Leddy, is a student at East State University, Tennessee.

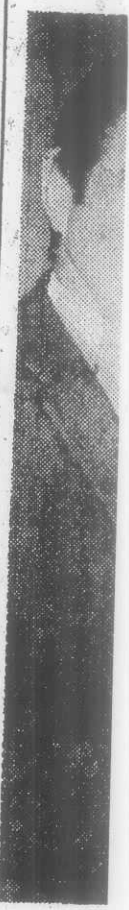
Other Irish placings were: P. J. Leddy (East State), 9th in 2 hours, 31 minutes, 37 seconds, and Patsy Durnin (East State), 16th in 2 hours, 42 minutes, 46 seconds.

Cusack covered the first ten miles in 51 minutes, 37 seconds, and went through the 20-mile mark in 1 hour, 43.43 seconds, so he was remarkably consistent all through. The Peachbowl Marathon holder was Jack Bachelor, one of America's best known long distance men, and Cusack was more than 2 minutes within his winning time.
