## BRANCHES DISCUSS IMPORTANT QUESTIONS

At a meeting of the County Limerick Federation of the Lubbur Party the following resolutions were unanimously adopted:—

"Rucckloing.—"That we call on the Co. Board of Health to carry out the Knockloing water scheme, which is of urgent necessity and of vital interest to the health of the people. The scheme has already been recommended, and we ask the Board to take the necessary steps to initiate the work."

"That we request the County Board of Health to expedite the building of cottages, and we regret the action of the Minister for Local Government and Public Health in reducing the cottage loan to 1120,000, thereby reducing the number of houses to be built, and we call on our T.Ds to urge the Minister to re-consider his decision in view of the large number of applicants for houses."

Proposed by Mr. M. Ryan, Paliasgrean:—"That we call on the Deputies for Limerick to urge the Minister for Local Government to give effect to the Report of the Cottage Purchase Commission by the immediate introduction of the necessary Bill."

"Distribution of lands—"That we reafilism our demand for immediate County Limerick, and we call on the Land Commission to expedite same in the interest of the landless men, cottlers, and disemployed estate workers in their respective areas."

"Galbaily—"That we call on the Limerick County Council to carry out their obligations under the Insurance Acts by the prompt stamping of the cards of those in their employment on roads and other public works."

Pallasgreen.—"That we appreciate the efforts of the Irish Labour Party to

John O'Grady has joined those famous

empty place here that can never be
filled. I like best to think of him as the
genial, kindly human being. His athletic
records are written on lasting memoriale, but his humanity and kindliness
are written only on the hearts of those
who knew him. It was my privilege to
be amongst those. And, although my
