Corporation received only £6 million to fund this outgoing.

The bad news continues on the water charge front. Fully £150,000 remains outstanding of the £900,000 which was expected to be raised. In the previous year City Hall also budgeted to raise £900,000, and actually exceeded this figure slightly, ending up with a £16,000 surplus in the account.

Service charges also had a serious deficit last year.

Calculating at about £1,200,000, City Hall waived

£400,000, leaving a theoretically collectable £800,000. But the collection raised barely £700,000.

However, the Corporation can take comfort from one fact — things were worse by £50,000 in '89.

The net result is that the Corporation is, as predicted, in the red to the tune of £3.7 million, separate from its huge capital debt. The bank is owed £1.3 million, and about £2.4 million cheques have been issued by City Hall but remain uncashed.
