Together with the Minister for Construction, Dr. Osmani Cienfuegos, and 71 other passengers they were held up at Shannon Airport since Friday night.

The Cuban Airlines Britania aircraft on which they were flying from Prague to Havana developed mechanical trouble. It was flown to the factory in England, and after repairs were carried out returned and continued its flight yesterday. On Saturday night the bearded Cuban leader with some friends paid a visit to Limerick.
