On Saturday next 130 female paupers from the Limerick workhouse will embark in the *Theron*, Jobblin, master, for Quebec. The ship, which is in the new dock, has been chartered for the purpose by Mr. John Sidley, with whom the guardians have contracted. About the end of the next month 250 more females will be sent out by the guardians, in one of Mr. Sidley's ships.

Bridget Kinnavane, inmate of the Limerick union workhouse, and one of the females selected for emigration, was found dead in her bed on Monday morning by a girl with whom she was sleeping.

In Killarney union a poor rate was this week struck varying from 1s. 1d. to 2s. 9d.

The guardians of the Fermoy union have raised the salaries of the medical officers of dispensaries to £90 per annum each.

There are 60 cases of Ophthalmia in Nenagh workhouse. No funds to credit of Guardians.

The English steamer which arrived in Cork yesterday, brought over thirty paupers transmitted to this country under the present law.
