IRISH SPIRIT TRADE PRICES.

By arrangement with the Ministry of Food, the several rections of the Spirit Trade in Ireland have agreed to a scale of inter-trade prices which will enable the Retail Branch of the Trade on and after the lat proximo to sell whiskey at the following prices: - Rate per glass, Is 8d, 10 glass bottle, 16. The whiskey so sold shall be of a strength not weaker than 25 degrees under proof as prescribed by the Food and Drugs Act. These prices represent the equivalent of the prices chargeable in Great Britsin, making allowance for the higher strength at which whiskey is sold in Ireland. The arrangement is sanctioned on the understanding that defaulters shall be penalised by the withholding of further supplies of whiskey by the Distilling and Wholesale Branches of the Trade.

Second Body Recovered.

The hody of the young lad Albert O'Driscoll, who lost his life by the capsizing of a boat in the Shannon at Doorass or Whit-Monday, was found yesterday by some, by who were fishing at Dastle Troy.
