From 1st February, 1854, to 30th May, 1854.

By the book kept by the four medical officers, I find  
that cholera has been found to exist in 606 houses of  
the poor, accompanied by poverty and filth. Of these  
(at the risk of life) I took immediately, on the dis-  
covery of disease, the following means of cleansing and  
purifying—

The Furniture removed, house cleansed, and whitewashed at public cost,	450.
Do. by notice to owner or occupier by private cost,	156.
Total as will appear by Books of Medical officers,	606.
Other Houses done at public cost from their poverty and filth,	30.
