may for fome time interrupt that compact which had taken place between France and Great Britain and Ireland, but clear I am, that it will ultimately be a means of cementing that alliance more firmly; for I must tell you, that the voice of the National Assembly, as well as of the whole kingdom feems to be to model our constitution, as nearly as possible, on your Magna Charta principles. The trial by Jury, in particular, is what we all most ardently strive for; fo that I think, if we adopt your constitution, we will not be backward in giving every preference and encouragement possible to many of your manufactures."
